Y. Hirata is unrelated to RN in terms of professional status, but is permanently his spiritual pillar. His name is to be presented here.

The Kita School of Kyoto University (partial)

This scheme is important.

Ryoji Noyori is a descendant of the huge Gen-itsu Kita School of Engineering at Kyoto University, which is dedicated to basic chemistry and its industrial development. He admired Ichiro Sakurada, a disciple of Kita and inventor of Vynylon, but later studied under Sisido and Nozaki to become an organic chemist. Ken-ichi Fukui (1981 Nobel laureate), a member of this school, is a theoretical chemist, but Noyori received a variety of personal guidance from him. Hisashi Yamamoto was mentored by Nozaki and E. J. Corey and is therefore Noyori's younger brother.
